

Ada Lovelace PhD Position in Mathematics and Computer Sciences

The Faculty for Mathematics and Computer Science of the Westfälische Wilhelms-Universität, Muenster, Germany, invites applicants for the

Ada Lovelace PhD Position

(75%, 13 TV-L).

The position is temporary for two years with the possibility to extend to a maximum of three years. The regular weekly working time is 39 hours and 50 minutes.

Applicants are expected to have

- A Masters degree or equivalent, giving access to doctoral studies in mathematics or computer sciences at WWU Muenster
- Above average final grades
- Integration into an existing work group / project group

The candidate is expected to graduate within three years. The position is funded through the program for female professors (Professorinnenprogramm II) and the Faculty to promote gender equalization for junior scientists. The position comes with additional resources for travelling and material expenses.

We actively encourage applications from suitably qualified women. Female candidates with equivalent qualifications and academic achievements will be preferentially considered. We also welcome applications from candidates with severe disabilities. Disabled candidates with equivalent qualifications will be preferentially considered.
